PRE-UFE PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

Your UFE procedure is scheduled for / / @ _____ A.M. at Sentara Virginia Beach General Hospital. We make every effort to stay on schedule but due to the unpredictable nature of medicine more urgent / emergent procedures must occasionally take priority. We do apologize in advance for any inconvenience or additional stress this may cause you.

- **YOU MAY NOT EAT** after midnight the night prior to your procedure. You may have clear liquids up to 2 hours before your procedure. Take your morning medications with sips of water.
- You may TAKE THE FOLLOWING MEDICATIONS the morning of your procedure:
 - Blood pressure medications
 - Heart and lung medications
 - Radin prep medication for contrast allergy patients.
 - Place <u>scopolamine patch</u> behind your ear before you go to bed, the night prior to your procedure. This was/will be called in to your pharmacy by our nurses.
 - Please bring a list of all medications with dose and frequency. You may bring your own medications if desired.
- **DISCONTINUE ALL MEDICATIONS LISTED** below at the appropriate times:
 - Aggrenox: stop 3 days prior to procedure
 - Aspirin: stop 5 days prior to procedure
 - Coumadin: stop 5 days prior to procedure
 - Heparin: stop 2-4 hours prior to procedure
 - Low Molecular Weight Heparin stop 24 hours prior to procedure
 - Persantine: stop 3 days prior to procedure
 - Plavix: stop 5 days prior to procedure if you have a drug eluting coronary stent discuss with your cardiologist before discontinuing
 - Ticlid: stop 5 days prior to procedure
- <u>DIABETIC PATIENTS</u> taking medications containing <u>METFORMIN</u> (<u>glucophage</u>) must stop this
 medication at the time of procedure. Metformin should not be resumed until 48 hours post
 procedure, after a serum creatinine level has been checked.
- **YOU MUST HAVE A DRIVER** Following your discharge from the hospital, you will NOT be allowed to drive for at least 24 hours, due to the sedation medications administered, you will need to have a designated driver to drive you home.
